

# VDOT 2017 Gravel Road Project

VDOT has confirmed that the gravel roads listed below will be restored this Spring and Summer in this year's enhanced care program. VDOT will trim brush and intrusive tree branches, clean up banks, restore and clean culverts and ditches, re-grade the road, apply new gravel, roll the gravel and apply dust suppressant as needed. Routine maintenance will continue to be applied to the balance of the roads. In addition, VDOT will be experimenting with a new approach to stabilizing problem areas of gravel road on a short section of Hogback Mountain Road.
