SNICKERSVILLE TURNPIKE ROAD CLOSURE SET FOR NEXT WEEK

Two-day closure planned for bridge replacement

Beginning at **7:00 am** on **Saturday, March 24, 2018**, Snickersville Turnpike (Route 734) in Loudoun County will be closed to through traffic between Airmont Road (Route 719) and Paxson Road (Route 725). The closure is expected to last 2 days, according to the Virginia Department of Transportation.

Drivers are asked to avoid the area while the bridge is being replaced. A detour using Paxson Road (Route 725) and Airmont Road (Route 719) is available to all traffic.

If weather does not allow for the construction to take place on March 24th & 25th the following Wednesday and Thursday, March 28th & 29th will be reserved as rain dates.
